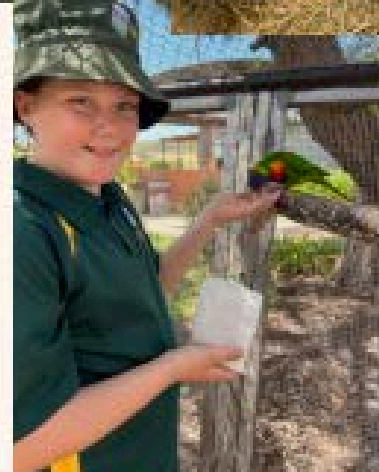
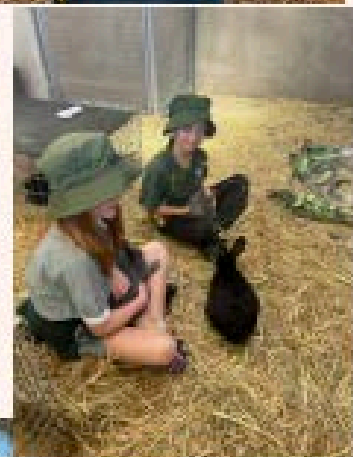
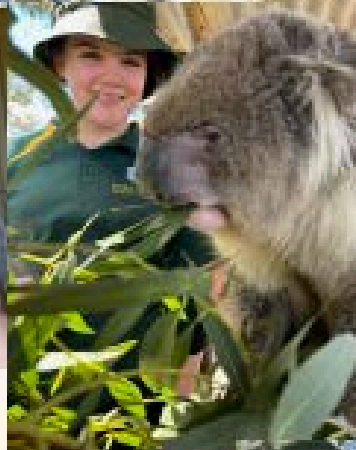
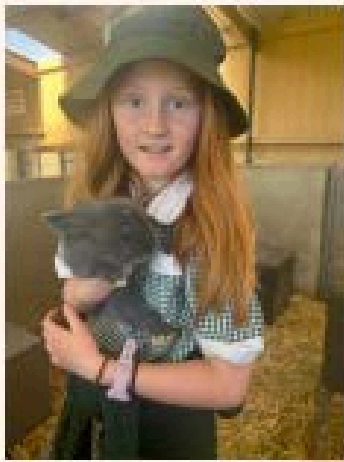
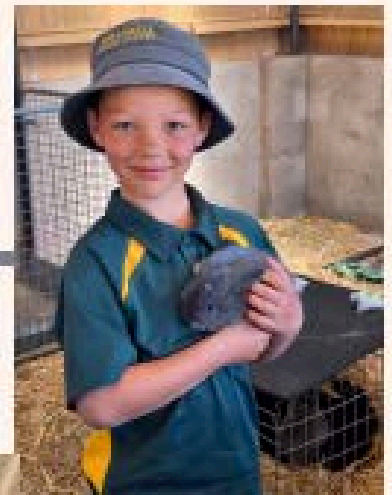
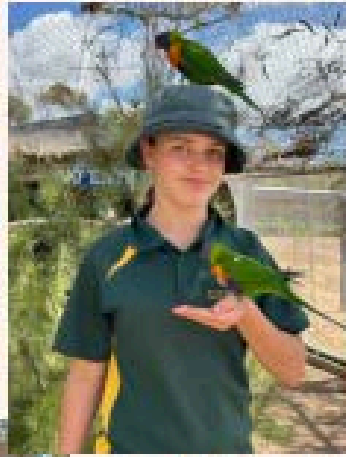
### **World Teacher Day**
